## In GB, female-led farms faced low yields, limited buyers, and lower returns. Most barely broke even on their potato crop. This was due to:



**Dependence** on middlemen for sales



Limited knowledge of farmers around regenerative, high-yield farming practices and agronomy know-how



Limited access to adequate capital



**Limited** financial literacy as well as limited health and hygiene literacy



## SI's interventions to solve agronomy problems included:



**Linked** farmers with new, **sustained buyers** for their produce



**Deployed 2 full-time agronomists** for hands-on support from planting to harvest



Introduced a cooperative partnership model to remove upfront costs



Provided ongoing training in farming, finance, and hygiene

## The impact:



Female farmers **gained access** to new sustained buyers and markets



Farmers **earned profits** on crops that previously resulted in losses



The intervention eventually strengthened local **female agri-business leadership** in an out-post region
